Nature of Work

The Professional Theatre Department at Dawson College is currently seeking candidates with a specific focus on voice, speech and singing. In addition to the minimum requirements, the candidate should possess the following qualifications: thorough knowledge of voice, speech and singing including vocalization, dialect work and vocal qualities, in addition to the mastering of the International Phonetic Alphabet.

Minimum requirements

- MA in Theatre and three (3) years professional experience in the particular field OR University degree and five (5) years professional experience in the particular field
- Teaching experience at the college level an asset
- Excellent English communication skills essential
- In order to be considered for a full teaching load, candidates must be able to teach courses in at least three of the following seven categories: movement, improvisation, voice, acting, dramaturgy, text, and drama.
